Attendance has been very poor throughout the beginning part of our year. Please remember that those who attend classes on a regular basis and who arrive on time are those who experience the most from their dance education.

Often when one student is absent, an instructor will need to repeat an entire lesson plan, arrange an extra rehearsal for the entire class or at the very least review choreography. Each class can be hindered by poor attendance and tardiness or can progress nicely with all striving to attend classes regularly. Poor attendance habits can also affect a student’s class placement and performance eligibility in our recital.

Please remember that there is an attendance policy. Only 6 absences are permitted from January until June.

STUDENTS WHO MISS MORE THAN 6 CLASSES FROM JANUARY UNTIL JUNE WILL BE UNABLE TO PERFORM IN THE ANNUAL RECITAL REGARDLESS OF THE PURCHASE OF COSTUMES OR TICKETS.

Please strive to have excellent attendance habits as everyone, including your child, will benefit!

Please remember that **tuition is currently due.**

Tuition payment is due on or before the 1st class of each month regardless if your child was in class or not.

All payments received after the 10th day of the month will have a \$10.00 late fee added to your account.

Note to Company Members: Company members are only permitted to miss 6 classes from September until June. Make sure you are at all remaining classes.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

All dancers must adhere to the dress code. A solid color black leotard and solid pink tights must be worn to all classes.

All students who are enrolled in Twinkle Stars I or II must have their hair pulled back in a ponytail, braid or bun. **ALL OTHER STUDENTS must wear a bun in ALL CLASSES.**

The only class observation that will be permitted is if a doctor’s note is provided and there is a physical injury.

The dance center does close if the weather becomes severe and driving conditions are dangerous. If this happens please call the dance center a half hour prior to your class to find out closing information. If there are no messages regarding class cancellation then classes will be held as scheduled.
